Who is eligible to apply?

- 1. Resident (s) of at least two years in the Town of Ripley.
- 2. Senior student (s) graduating from Ripley Central School or its successor by tuition.
- 3. Accepted at a college/university.

What are the criteria for selecting the recipients?

- 1. Student (s) with good academic achievement, not necessarily at the top of his/her class, good character, a strong work ethic and community involvement.
- 2. Priority will be given to student pursuing but not limited to a degree in one of the following: elementary education, agriculture and/or conservation or a health related field.
