Application Process

- Interested students should complete the application and submit it to their High School Guidance Department by <u>April 1st.</u> Alternatively, High School, BOCES or P -TECH personnel may submit an application on a deserving student's behalf.
- 2. Students must submit two recommendation forms, completed by staff personnel, along with their application.
- 3. Student must meet eligibility requirements.
- 4. Applications will be reviewed and a selection will be made by a committee which will include family members, friends and school representatives.

Who is eligible to apply?

- 1. Graduating High School Seniors from Forestville, Fredonia, or Dunkirk.
- 2. Those planning on a career in the trades
- 3. Priority will be given to those interested in air conditioning, carpentry, electrical, heating, masonry or plumbing; strong consideration will be given to those interested in other trades, such as agriculture, conservation, emergency services or forestry.

What are the criteria for selecting the recipients?

- 1. Demonstrated positive attitude and an appreciation for life.
- 2. Likelihood of success in selected field of work.
- 3. Priority will be given to those who have volunteered or worked in the community during their high school career.
- 4. Has demonstrated a caring and respectful attitude towards others, including administrators, teachers, community members and their peers throughout their
