### **Application Process**

- Interested students should return completed applications and recommendation forms to the Northern Chautaugua Community Foundation by **April 15th.**
- Students must meet all eligibility requirements.

## Who is eligible to apply?

(must meet all requirements)

- Applicants must be graduating high school seniors or matriculating secondary education students.
- Applicants must reside in northern Chautauqua County.
- Applicants must be planning to continue his/her education on a full-time basis at a trade or vocational school, or a college.

## **Criteria for selecting recipients**

- Preference will be given to students:
  - planning to attend a trade or vocational school
  - pursuing a career in the trades
  - participating in Boys Scouts of America
- Demonstrates the 12 points of the Scout Law: trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly courte-ous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent
- Embraces everyday life as a loving, caring, generous, family-oriented, genuine, sincere, and humorous individual
- Attends BOCES or has course work of a vocational nature
- Possesses school pride
- Volunteers in the community
- Financial need
