

Beverly Ann Wood Edelmann Memorial Scholarship

Application Process

- Interested students must submit a one page typed personal statement that discusses their plans and dreams beyond high school and how this scholarship will help them achieve their goals.
- 2. Students will provide two letters of recommendation from teachers, coaches, supervisors, or other individuals (excluding family members) in a leadership role.

Who is Eligible to Apply? (must meet all requirements)

- 1. Senior students graduating from Chautauqua Lake, Sherman, or Westfield high schools who attended their high school at a minimum for their junior and senior years.
- 2. Students accepted at an accredited two or four-year post secondary program as a full-time student.
- 3. Students who have earned a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 4. In addition, preference will be given to students who have participated in high school and/or community activities.

Criteria for Selecting Recipients

- * Preference will be given to students who have participated in high school and/or community activities
- * Strong work ethic
- * Willingness to sacrifice for others and the greater good
- * Kindness to others
- * Evidence of the qualities listed above through letters of recommendation
- * Content and sincerity of personal statement as part of the application process
