Application Process

2. Students must meet all eligibility requirements and submit the recommendation form with their application.
3. Students must include an essay of no more than 500 words, explaining how they match the criteria of a modest, friendly, uplifting, and welcoming nature with examples.



Who is eligible to apply? (must meet all requirements)

1. Graduating students from Fredonia High School pursuing post-secondary education at a college or university.

Criteria for selecting recipients

1. Participation in music and/or bowling during high school career.
2. Possesses a modest, friendly, uplifting, and welcoming nature.
3. Students pursuing a degree in Business, Music, or Political Science at a college or university will be given special consideration.

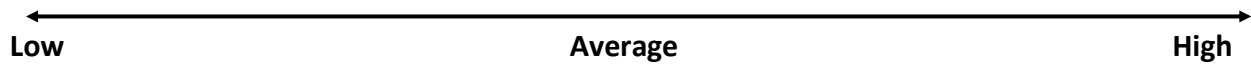

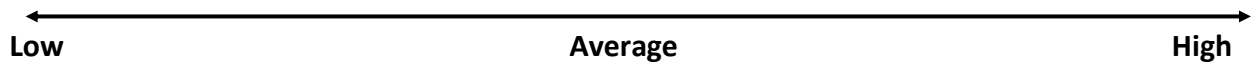
