What is a Community Donor Advised Fund?

A Community Donor Advised Fund (CDAF) is a charitable fund held at the NCCF for the benefit of a particular community. CDAFs are created with contributions from community members and are invested for growth. The income is used to support worthwhile community projects. A committee of local individuals recommends where to direct distributions from the fund.

How does TWF serve our community?

- By providing past, present and future residents the opportunity to leave something specifically to benefit the Westfield Community.
- By establishing endowments to benefit the community both now and in the future.
- By strengthening the not-for-profit organizations that serve the Westfield area.
- By promoting local philanthropy
- By providing donors with a tax deductible and convenient means to meet their charitable goals.

How does it work?

Each year, charitable organizations in the Westfield area submit grant applications for the committee's consideration.
